We are pleased to announce that the **21<sup>st</sup> Annual Workshop of the National Reference Laboratories for Fish Diseases** will be held in May 30<sup>th</sup> - 31<sup>st</sup> at the premises of the National Veterinary Institute in Kgs. Lyngby, Denmark. The National Veterinary Institute (DTU-VET) has recently moved and is now located at the DTU main campus. Please see the enclosed map and instructions for guidance.

<u>Please note that no official invitations will be sent from the Commission to the CVO of your</u> <u>country and it will be our responsibilities as NRLs to assure the participation of the right</u> <u>colleagues</u>.

The cost for holding the workshop is now funded directly to the EURL and the Commission Regulation allows us to cover travel and hotel expenses as well as meals for one participant from each Member State. In addition, one person from non-Member but associated countries can be refunded. For practical reasons (limited space); if more than one participant from each country wishes to participate, it should be arranged with the organisers. Due to budget restrictions, we kindly ask you to reserve your flight ticket as soon as possible and take advantage of "early bird" reservations in order to keep expenses as low as possible.

Please consider that:

- If you take part in the Workshop as <u>invited speaker</u>, <u>NRL representative of Member State</u> (one for each Member State) or <u>NRL representative of an associate Member State</u> (one for each associated country) select the corresponding type of registration when signing up. In these cases:
  - You will have to arrange your hotel reservation with the form attached to this letter and specify that DTU-VET will cover the related expenses in the form.
  - You will have to reserve and pay your flight ticket (it will be reimbursed afterwards).
  - You <u>WILL NOT</u> have to transfer money related to the banquet dinner, lunches or coffees.
  - You will have to scan and send us flight boarding cards, invoices/receipts with factual paid amount for travel expenses and other costs incurred in connection with





## How to reach DTU building 101 from the hotel

Distance is 15 km, approx. 50 min. by public transport. You walk from hotel Cabinn Scandinavia to Forum St. and get on the metro M2 towards Lufthavnen St. Get off the metro at Nørreport St. and walk approx. 4 min. to bus 150s or 15E at Nørreport St. (Nørre Voldgade) (see picture on the right). Get off the bus at Rævehøjvej, DTU and walk approx. 6 min. to DTU building 101 where signs will lead you to conference room S01 in building 101.
