<u>Please note that no official invitation will be sent from the Commission to the CVO of your country</u> and it will be our responsibility as NRLs to assure the participation of the right colleagues.

The cost for holding the workshops is funded by the European Commission through the EURL and the Commission Regulation allows us to cover travel and hotel expenses as well as meals for one participant from each EU Member State attending in person to each of the workshops. In addition, one person from non-Member, but associated countries, is allowed reimbursement. Due to EURL funding changes, the EFTA countries (Iceland, Liechtenstein, Norway and Switzerland) will not be reimbursed this year and therefore have to sign up as "Others". For practical reasons (limited space); if more than one participant from each country wishes to participate, it should be arranged with the organisers. Due to budget restrictions, we kindly ask you to reserve your flight ticket as soon as possible and take advantage of "early bird" reservations in order to keep expenses as low as possible.

In order to facilitate the participation to the workshops, this year they will take place as Hybrid events, so it will be possible to connect online and attend remotely. A link to attend the meeting will be made available at a later stage.

 You will then be reimbursed as quickly as possible.
- Due to EURL funding changes, the EFTA countries (Iceland, Liechtenstein, Norway and Switzerland) will not be reimbursed this year and therefore has to sign up as "Others; 1) non-EU members and 2) additional delegates from EU and associated countries" (see below).

If you take part in the workshops and you do not belong to one of the categories mentioned above, please select "Others; 1) non-EU members and 2) additional delegates from EU and associated countries" when signing up. The participation in the workshops cost 125 DKK per day to cover lunch and coffee while travel expenses and accommodation are not included. There will be a banquet dinner for the AW for NRL for fish diseases on May 30th and one for AW for NRL for crustacean diseases on May 31st, each dinner will cost 500 DKK; you will have to transfer the related amount of money to cover expenses for the banquet dinner, through the online system using a credit card.


